

## **HYMER premiere at Caravan Salon 2009**

### **The new HYMER T-Class 2x2**

At the Caravan Salon exhibition, HYMER will be premiering a motorhome with a difference in the HYMER T-Class 2x2. This new semi-integrated model, which is ideally equipped to sleep up to four people, is based on the layout of the HYMER T-Class 654 CL on a Fiat ladder-type chassis with a wide tread design and 130 hp engine.

The highlight of this semi-integrated is the comfortable foldaway double bed provided in addition to the double bed in the rear. Measuring 1.95 metres long by 1.40 metres wide, the new bed also folds away to allow an unprecedented headroom of 1.85 metres.

The rear double bed, measuring 2.00 metres by 1.45 metres, is among the most generous in this vehicle class. An optional (foldaway) wider section at the foot of the bed makes for a luxurious sleeping space in the bottom area as well.

The living area readily accommodates six people, with a comfortable seating group, swivel cab seats and metre-wide side couch. In fact the HYMER T-Class is remarkably spacious all-round. Large stowage compartments (with lockable doors) in the cab area, hanging cupboards on the right and left-hand side below the foldaway bed, two shoe boxes in the entrance area and the "half-size" yet roomy 90-centimetre high garage with large door are just a few examples of the exceptional stowage capacity of this model.

The entire vehicle is ergonomically designed to ensure maximum freedom of movement. The same goes for the compact, L-shaped kitchen with its generous 150-litre refrigerator (optional). The kitchen can still be used when the bed is folded down.

Ample space is also provided in the new, large bathroom, which is equipped with a bench toilet and a completely separate shower compartment reached via a swivel door mechanism. For added convenience, the shower also features a wooden rack built into the shower tray. A newly integrated window and a range of practical accessories ensure a pleasurable user experience.

This experience is further enhanced by the optional hot-air Thermal Floor, which provides efficient heating for the bathroom and the vehicle as a whole. This Thermal Floor has been newly developed by HYMER (patent pending). The standard heating system and an additional fan blow hot air through the regular “heating channels” drilled into the floor, warming it up with high efficiency.

Another notable feature is the continuous, “barrier-free“ nature of the floor, with the cab, living area and kitchen all on one level. In short, the innovative concept of the HYMER T-Class 2x2 puts it among the elite of vehicles making their debut at this year’s Caravan Salon exhibition.
